Spotlight on Teaching: Participants will participate in a one day development day, based within a successful school setting. During this day participants will have the opportunity to engage in a range of focused observations, learning walks and have the opportunity to reflect as a group. Following on from this day, participants will be placed in geographical learning partnership and participate mutual lesson observations. Finally participants will come together to participate in a half day reflection session, sharing lessons learnt and identifying next steps.

Two modules are still to run this academic year.

Spotlight on Lesson Design – 28th April full day and 19th May half day at Candleby Lane. The anatomy of a successful lesson is a judicious mix of good pedagogy, careful preparation, effective subject knowledge, enthusiasm and engagement. The best lessons are defined by good relationships, great outcomes and consistent reflection day in and day out.

Spotlight on Creating the Climate for Learning – 9th June full day and 23rd June half day at Candleby Lane. When you walk into some classrooms there is a tangible energy, a visible commitment to learning and the sense of it being a safe place to take risks. All children are engaged in learning, the culture is one of inclusion, aspiration and mutual respect. When children feel safe, recognise that they belong and are thoroughly engaged, they are more likely to take risks with their learning and to enjoy challenges. Learning should be fun!
